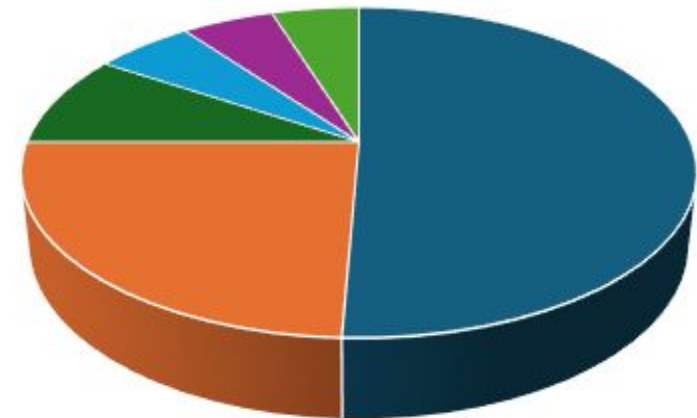

# Voting Process



Use the email that you use to login to your SportsEngine account to login to the Zoom meeting and identify yourself on the sign-in form with the same email used for SporsEngine. This will allow the proctors to validate voting eligibility by matching both email addresses.

1. Log into Zoom AGM meeting with email: [sacunitedagm@gmail.com](mailto:sacunitedagm@gmail.com)
2. Inside the Zoom chat. You will find the [AGM Sign In Form](#) link. Click it. It will have you input the following information
  - Email (Input SportsEngine email address)
    - Use your SportsEngine email. For example: [sacunitedagm@gmail.com](mailto:sacunitedagm@gmail.com)
  - Input YOUR First and Last Name
  - Submit



## **Voting Process (continued)**

---

- 3. Following the conclusion of the AGM. Zoom will detail a report of the participants that attended the meeting. Only names and email addresses are detailed on the Zoom report**
- 4. Using the report from Zoom, Proctors will match email addresses using Sportsengine & the Sign-in Sheet.**
- 5. Upon validation, Sac United Proctors will email ballots to the email address that was verified.**
- 6. Proctors will close the polls 2 hours from the time the email was sent.**
- 7. Proctors will review the votes and determine a winner within 24hrs. Via email and post winners on the AGM page on [www.sacunited.com/elections](http://www.sacunited.com/elections)**
